## "See-Me" Connecting Tunnel

Thank you for purchasing the "SEE-ME" CONNECTING TUNNEL. We at PPT are confident that our tunnel will provide you and your children with endless hours of creative fun and enjoyment year-round.

We encourage you to read and understand each step of the set-up process prior to assembly. Invite your child to help. Set-up is an easy and fun process.

### Let's get started!

#### PLEASE READ ALL OF THE DIRECTIONS PRIOR TO ASSEMBLY.

1. First untie the ties and pull back the nylon flap (connecting lip) that holds the tunnel in the collapsed position. The tunnel will open up automatically, as it is basically one large spring.
2. When the tunnel is fully extended, it can be used alone or attached to another tunnel, or any Pacific Play Tent product.

#### For use with Any Pacific Play Tent

1. First begin by rolling up the flap (if attached on the play tent) covering the opening where you want to connect the tunnel. Nylon ties will keep the flap from unraveling.
2. Now, insert the "See-Me" Connecting Tunnel into the hole (the diameter of the tunnel will appear to be larger than the diameter of the hole. You are right. It is. However, the tunnel is made to fit snug and will go in quite easily.
3. For optimal fit, insert the play tunnel 6 to 8 inches into the tent.





#### For use with Another Tunnel

Your "See-Me" Connecting Tunnel has Velcro on both ends. Place the end until the soft Velcro (end without extra fabric) into the other tunnel with the excess fabric. There is Velcro inside the connecting lip (excess fabric end) and it will adhere to the end without the excess fabric. Simply press the two pieces of Velcro together and you now have two connected tunnels. You can connect an unlimited amount of tunnels together in this manner.

#### Putting the Connecting Tunnel away

To put the Connecting Tunnel away, compress the tunnel down until it is completely flat. Then pull the extended nylon flap cover back over the compressed tunnel and tie the tunnel tightly to secure it. Remember to always keep a firm grip on the Connecting Tunnel while compressing it down.

#### Some additional Tips

-  The Play Tunnel should be assembled with adult supervision. Do not allow children to jump on the tunnel.
-  Use the "SEE-ME" Connecting tunnel on a soft or smooth surface only. Avoid sharp objects while playing.
-  Do not use the play tunnel near any open flame or fireplace.
-  The play tunnel is made from water repellent nylon. However, tunnel should not be left in the yard for prolonged periods of time, as sunlight can weaken or fade the nylon. Continued exposure to water (from sprinklers) can cause mildewing.
